2. At the outset Joint Secretary (Sports) MYA&S welcomed the members and desired to know the current status of the Indian team in regards to preparations for U-17 FIFA World Cup, 2017 and the update on their training in national camps & abroad. He also inquired about the funds being raised through FIFA for the training of U-17 team.

3. The Director National Camps & Scouting, informed the members, that presently the Indian U-17 FIFA World Cup team is training in Germany under the Chief Head Coach Mr. Nicolai Adams The team has played matches with some of the best Junior Clubs in Europe & have won a few of them . He also agreed to share all data on the teams performance with MYA&S/SAI for monitoring.

4. The Committee discussed in detail the preparations of the Indian U-17 FIFA World Cup team. The AIFF representative made a presentation on the planned National camps and Competition exposures for the Indian team. He also highlighted the importance of the National Talent Scouting Project, which was essential as a constant feeder line for the National team as part of the ACTC for the U-17 FIFA World Cup team.

- 5. The Secretary (Sports) asked AIFF to check internally, if FIFA is providing any financial support specifically for the preparation of our team for the FIFA U17 World Cup 2017. AIFF clarified that FIFA is not providing any financial support particularly for the preparation of our team. However AIFF had assured that, if required in future FIFA, would provides the Support to AIFF and the same would be informed to MYA&S /SAI. Further any extra expenditure over and above the approved ACTC would be incurred by AIFF.
- 6. The Director National Camps & Scouting explained about the selection trial process for talent scouting wide publicity would be provided to talent scouting through standard press release in the local media (newspapers, cable TV operators etc.. In this regard, Secretary (Sports) suggested that local scouting at grass-root level be organized through the concept of game shows to draw more youngsters. It was agreed to by the AIFF officials.
- 7. DG SAI further clarified that SAI and AIFF have already signed a MOU to work together in respect of talent Scouting through various SAI Centres across the country with focus on far off places of the country and tribal belts. It was appreciated by Secretary (Sports).
- 8. A budget of Rs. Approx. Rs. 732.40 lacs for ACTC on training-cum preparation of the Indian team for U-17 FIFA World Cup 2017 for the Year 2015-16 was approved, (Annex-1). This is to be circulated on reimbursement basis to AIFF.
