MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SECRETRAY SPORTS ON 3.03.16 IN HIS CONFERENCE ROOM OF NDTL BUILDING, JN STADIUM, NEW DELHI TO FINALIZE THE ANNUAL CALENDAR FOR TRAINING & COMPETITION (ACTC) OF JOINT FOOTBALL & U-17 FOOTBALL WORLD CUP TEAM FOR THE YEAR 2016-17

A meeting to finalize the ACTC for the discipline of Football for the year 2016-17 was held under the Chairmanship of Mr. Rajeev Yadav, Secretary (Sports), in his Conference Room in NDTL Building at 3.00 PM, J N Stadium Complex, New Delhi. List of officials who attended the meeting is at **Annexure-I**.

- 2. At the outset, The Chairman welcomed all the participants and asked the officials from the AIFF to report on the activities. The General Secretary AIFF Mr. Kushal Das explained in detail about the structure of State Associations and active participation of State Associations engaged in the promotion of football in order mainly West Bengal, Goa, Maharashtra and Kerala are the major states who conduct State leagues for age group and actively participate in National Championship on a regular basis.
- 3. The AIFF also informed about the participation of Indian National Senior/Junior/Sub Junior teams (Men & Women) at international level, which will help in improving there world ranking.
- 4. Chairman also observed that the AIFF should undertake the responsibility of training the Juniors and Sub-Juniors in the National Coaching Camps; they should be allowed to have international exposures and participate in international competitions.
- 5. The Chairman emphasized on Junior development plans and also the growth of Women Football in India .AIFF assured that this issue be addressed by planning more National camps & International exposure for them ACTC 2016-17.
- 6. The Chairman approved the proposal of the AIFF for the ACTC 2016-17 with a Budget of Rs. 4.50 Crores for Football & additionally Rs 8.30 Crores for preparation of the Indian U-17 World cup Football team.
- 7. The ACTC Proposed by AIFF is placed at Annexure- II for -Football and at Annexure III for -preparation of U-17 Indian World cup team
 - 8. The chairmen directed that the following general guideline be followed :-

ACTC Football- - Rs. 4.50 Crores

c. Rs. 2.00 Crore out of the approved budget to be dedicated for National Coaching Camps.

d. Rs. 2.50 Core out of the approved budget to be dedicated for International Participation/ training exposures primarily for Juniors & Women.

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<u>Preparations of U-17 World cup Indian Football Team- Rs. 8.30 Crores</u>

a. Rs. 1.59 Crore out of the approved budget to be dedicated for National Coaching Camps including internal travel by II AC train

b. Rs. 4.59 Core out of the approved budget to be dedicated for International participation.

c. Rs. 0.98 Core out of the approved budget to be dedicated for Supporting Personal including foreign coach.

d. Rs. 1.14 Core out of the approved budget to be dedicated for SAI talent Scouting for U-17 World Cup project as Youth development plan.

- 9. NSF to highlight the development plan for training and up-gradation of coaches, referees, judges, jury, technical officials etc.
- 10. Details of fund mobilized through sponsorships for amateur sportspersons be indicated by NSF. In case NSF is not getting any sponsorship money for amateur sportspersons, then a certain portion of professional league money (If applicable) may be kept for ACTC.
- 11. Funds only to be released for National Championships, once the date & venue is announced and assessed for suitability.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
