

Note on efforts for having dope free sports & compliance to WADA/NADA Code along with details of cases found positive during the last calendar year and action taken thereon.

All India Football Federation conducts anti-doping tests in coordination with the NADA of India for the players playing in the Hero Indian Super League and Hero I-League. Players are also tested at the various National Team Camps that are held throughout India. These anti-doping tests are conducted both for Male and Female players respectively.

As a new initiative, from 2019, the AIFF in coordination with the NADA of India has started a new awareness program where in all the players and support staff of the clubs are being educated by NADA appointed officials on the following objectives :

- To create anti doping awareness among sportspersons and support personnel including stakeholders.
- Dissemination of anti doping information with the help of digital/electronic media.
 - With the aim to decrease the incidence of doping amongst Indian Sportspersons and promote fair play spirit. Along with the help of the National Anti Doping Agency of India, we plan to take this forward and keep educating the stakeholders in Football regarding anti-doping. There has been one positive case found in 2019. The player was under provisional suspension between April to September 2019 which was the suspension period decided by NADA for the positive case.
